Housing:

What constitutes affordable housing?

How is this achieved?

How is this funded?

Who has nomination rights?

What arrangements have been made, if any, with Housing Associations?

Will the affordable housing be on the open market or through a social landlord?

School:

We understand that there are plans for a 40 dwelling development in Chartham.

Is the Chartham development contributing financially to Chartham school?

Will any spaces available there be taken up by the development in Chartham?

Site concerns:

Is there a recommended play area or open space for new developments?

We have a limited amount of time to meet your deadline for a response to the amended applications and need answers to these questions before this response can be finalised so prompt answers would be appreciated.
