FOOTBALL PITCH DRAINAGE

Drainage required to football pitch, due to frequency of pitch being waterlogged resulting in games being cancelled. This scheme should help alleviate the water logging that has occurred since the housing development of Arden Grange.

Drain the football pitch area of the Recreation Ground by laying a main drain along the bottom of the touch line and then connecting laterals running across the pitch at 5M spacings. All drains laid approximately 500-550MM deep, back filled with beech to within 100MM of ground level then topped with soil and re-seeded
