Good evening and welcome to tonight's Chilham Parish Council meeting

The Parish Council meeting on the 5<sup>th</sup> of September was disrupted when Councillors realised the meeting was being filmed and recorded. The use of a mobile telephone torch caused a disturbance during the meeting.

The filming and recording of Parish Council meetings is permittable under law. The filming and recording of meetings needs to respect the right of the public to anonymity. This is the case even if the person does not intend to publish their film or recording. Therefore, before any filming or recording takes place the Chair needs to be able to announce this to allow any member of the public to leave before any filming or recording takes place. Failure to comply with this may lead to the meeting being suspended.

Whether filming or recording takes place the official record of the meeting is the agreed minutes only.

The Parish Council also received an anonymous letter deliberately wrongly addressed. In light of this I am confirming that the Parish Council does not respond to anonymous correspondence.
